Who can apply? Members of Scoliosis Support and Research (SSR) affected by scoliosis. Small grants are available to those who require equipment or travel expenses to appointments. The maximum amount granted is £500 and applicants can only apply once per year. At this time we can fund only NHS-related requirements. We do not fund costs related to private treatment.
